## ► New ISL Publication – ISL Shipping Statistics Yearbook 2019

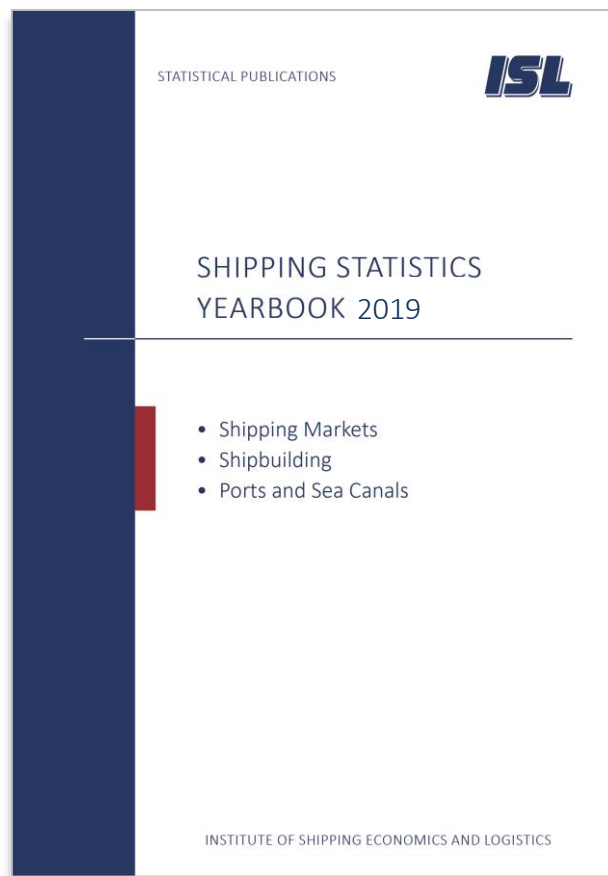
